JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to step-up pay benefits at par with his junior counterpart of reserved category Sh. Kheta Ram JE (Retd.) w.e.f. 26.11.1981 as ASSA and 11.07.1985 as SSA in view of law laid down by this Court in CWP No. 5956 of 2008, titled as Charan Dass Deputy Superintendent vs. State of Haryana and also instructions issued by the Government of Haryana from time to time with further prayer to release all the financial benefits along-with interest @12% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated September 09, 2016 (P-6) was made to respondent No.2, which did not fetch any reply. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (P-6) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, as well as in view of judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 5956 of 2008 and instructions issued by Government of Haryana from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
