AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner has averred that the roll number issued to him to take the 'Law of Evidence' examination of the 5th semester of the 3 years Law Course of the Panjabi University, Regional Centre, Bathinda has been withdrawn on the ground of shortage of lectures.

As per the material placed on the record total 45 lectures were held in the subject of 'Law of Evidence' of the 5th semester and the petitioner attended only 22 of them as against the requirement of 33 lectures. According to the Condonation Rules a shortage of 10 lectures was condoned but that still left a shortage of one lecture.

Learned counsel states that what is now going to happen is that the petitioner would lose six months of his study since he would now be allowed to take this examination only with the next year examination alongwith 5th semester. He however states that there is a power with the Vice Chancellor to permit the petitioner to take the examination alongwith

In the circumstances, even while dismissing this petition the petitioner is permitted to file a representation to the Vice Chancellor of the Panjabi University praying for permission to take the examination of 5th semester 'Law of Evidence' alongwith 6th semester examination and the Vice Chancellor is directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
