Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in respect of the grievance of the petitioners they have got a legal notice issued to the respondents on 13.06.2017, a copy of which is Annexure P-4, on which no decision has been taken so far.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of what is contained in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to go into the grievance of the petitioners and to take a decision on the said legal notice (if not already taken), by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is also clarified that in case a speaking order has already been passed giving such detailed reasons, then only a short order need be passed, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed (if any).
