Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that she has got instructions to give an undertaking on behalf of the petitioners to vacate the premises in dispute within a period of one month.

In view of the undertaking given by learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction on the basis of undertaking that the petitioners will hand over the vacant possession of House No.853, Indira Colony, Manimajra, U.T., Chandigarh to respondent No.2 within a period of one month. The petitioners will furnish an affidavit before the District Magistrate, U.T. Chandigarh, within a period of 15 days undertaking that the petitioners will not create any third party right and will give vacant possession of the entire portion in occupation of the petitioners in the above said house to respondent No.2 within one month.

In case of violation of the undertaking, it will be open to respondent No.2 to launch contempt proceedings against the petitioners besides seeking the implementation of the order of eviction.
