The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to the respondents to issue a passport to him.

Interestingly, the petitioner has also attached an order dated 18.11.2015 by which he was informed that his file regarding passport application No.CH3067681410014 has been closed on the basis of which he has prayed for the issuance of the passport. The petitioner has not challenged the said order, which was passed way back on 18.11.2015 and has only prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus, which cannot be ordered until and unless the order dated 18.11.2015 is held to be illegal and is set aside. Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable and the same is hereby dismissed.
