JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of order dated 03.11.2014 (P-9) whereby, her request for payment of pension has been rejected and for directing the respondents to sanction the pension payment order on account of her retirement from service on 30.04.2014 and also to grant gratuity and arrears of pension, after necessary correction of her date of regularization in service in accordance with letter dated 04.06.1999 (P-4) as other similarly situated employees who

were appointed on compassionate ground were granted similar benefit with further direction to respondents to decide the representation dated 26.12.2014 (P-10).

2. At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that all the retiral benefits have already been disbursed/released to the petitioner during the pendency of instant petition and nothing remains to be paid. Moreover, petitioner has assured that she will withdraw the instant petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not deny the afore-said fact as well as letter written to Executive Engineer, Gurdaspur Division UBDC, Gurdaspur (Annexure R-3).

3. A perusal of letter dated 08.04.2016 (R-3) written by the petitioner makes it crystal clear that she has already collected the entire amount accrued to her on account of her superannuation and nothing remains due.

4. In view of afore-said aspects as well as letter (R-3) written by the petitioner, instant petition is dismissed being fully satisfied.
