Petitioner seeks regularization from an earlier date, i.e., 01.10.2003, on the ground that junior, namely, Sanjay Kumar, has been regularized as Salesman, vide order dated 07.07.2004 (Annexure P-6).

It is the case of the petitioner that he had joined service on 04.12.1993 and his services were terminated on 10.05.1996. He had preferred an industrial dispute, which was decided in his favour on 26.09.2006 (Annexure P-1) and he was reinstated in service, with continuity of service and 50% back wages, from the date of the issuance of the demand notice. He has been regularized on 09.09.2014, with immediate effect (Annexure P-3).

Counsel submits that legal notice dated 11.11.2017 (Annexure P-11) has been served upon the respondent-Corporation, whereby all the necessary facts have been mentioned and therefore, he submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent within a time-bound frame.

Keeping in view the fact that the respondent is yet to take a decision on the said representation, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by calling upon the respondent to file reply.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above pleaded facts, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 11.11.2017 (Annexure P-11) within a period of 4 months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the relief as claimed is to be denied, a reasoned order be passed and be conveyed to the petitioner.
