Through instant petition, the petitioners seek a direction to respondent No.2 to grant permission for sale of 0.32 bore Revolver No.D-3094. In this context, the petitioner has already submitted an application to the Deputy Commissioner, Jind, dated 23.01.2017 Annexure P-5.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any sufficient reason for issuing a direction, at this stage, for enforcement of any legal rights of the petitioner as the application has been submitted only on 23.01.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Jind to consider application Annexure P-5 expeditiously.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Magistrate, Jind to look into the matter and ensure that application of the petitioner for permission to sell .32 bore Revolver No.D-3094 against arms licence No.187 DM/Jind/December 1995, is considered and decided expeditiously.

The petitioner is directed to make a request in writing to the District Magistrate, Jind for considering his application for permission for sale of the above said weapon. In case, any such application is filed, the District Magistrate, Jind will issue necessary directions for considering application and passing final order within a period of two months.
