As per pleadings on record, petitioner had joined the Industrial Training Institute, Nabha under the Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, State of Punjab on 01.10.2010 as Instructor under a Guest Faculty Scheme.

The instant writ petition was instituted in the year 2014 seeking issuance of directions to restrain the respondent authorities to make fresh appointments and to fill the vacancy against which the petitioner had been working till such time a regularly appointed candidate does not join service.

Mr. Gurnam Singh, learned counsel representing the petitioner very fairly apprises the Court that after filing of the petition a regularly appointed candidate has joined service. He submits that nothing would survive in the instant petition.
