Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, mandamus, prohibition etc. for directing the respondents to prepare the revenue record in accordance with provisions of Section 32 of Punjab Land Revenue Act with respect to land came from State of Uttar Pradesh to State of Haryana, for consolidation of the land.

Short reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 by way of affidavit has been filed in the Court today, whereby as per order dated 19.01.2015 (Annexure R-1), grievance of the petitioner has been redressed. The order therein has been passed under Section 32 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

Para No.3 of the reply also reveals that there shall be no dispossession of the petitioner. Same reads thus:-

“3. That further it is also submitted that answering respondents are not going to dispossess the petitioner neither going to change the nature of suit property.”

Thus, grievance of the petitioner stands vindicated.

In view of the aforementioned fact, no cause of action survives in the present writ petition.

Writ petition is rendered disposed of as infructuous.
