Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner having secured 65.5% marks in the General Category in the selection process for appointment to the post of a Male Constable, with the last selected candidate also having secured as many marks as per the notice Annexure P-3 issued by the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission on 17.07.2017 (a copy of which is Annexure P-3), and with a large number of candidates not having joined as Constables, he is entitled to be appointed to the said post even in order of merit, against the vacancies not filled in.

Upon the aforesaid averments having been made, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the legal notice got issued by the petitioner on 09.11.2017, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-6 with the petition, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
