It is not in dispute that against the impugned order dated 24.8.2017, passed by Debts Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh, closing right of the petitioner to admission and denial of the documents produced by the bank, statutory appeal is maintainable before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal (for short, 'the Appellate Tribunal'). Accordingly, we relegate the petitioner to avail of its statutory remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that certified copy of the order has been produced before this court along with the writ petition, which may be required by the petitioner to enable it to file appeal before the Appellate Tribunal. He may be returned the same as the petitioner will file a true photo copy of the order. He requested for doing the needful today itself as the petitioner may have to approach the Appellate Tribunal tomorrow, the next date of hearing before the DRT being
