Petitioners are seeking a writ of mandamus to pass an order in favour of the petitioners for transfer at the place of their own choice.

Reliance has been placed upon an order passed by this Court in **CWP No. 17240-2016, Anand Kumar vs. State of Haryana and another,** dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-10). It is not disputed that after the passing of the order, the petitioners have not approached the respondents for necessary relief. A writ of mandamus would only lie when the respondents have been approached for the necessary grievance and there is inaction on the part of respondents.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to approach the respondents at the first instance by giving necessary details regarding the petitioners and does not press the present petition at this stage.

Disposed of accordingly.
