Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to release the entire pensionary benefits i.e. Gratuity, ex-gratia, GIS, Leave Encashment, GPF etc. of late Sh. Amarjit Singh who died on 22.04.2016 along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Since there is a dispute amongst the LRs of Sh. Amarjit Singh inter se with regard to the retiral benefits i.e. Gratuity, ex-gratia, GIS, Leave Encashment, GPF etc., matter is required to be decided on the basis of evidence to be adduced by the parties in the Civil Court. As such, instant writ petition is not maintainable.

- Accordingly, instant petition stands dismissed.

- However, petitioners would be at liberty to approach the Civil Court for getting their grievances, if any, redressed.
