Admittedly, the petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present petition to challenge only the notice dated 05.12.2017 (Annexure P-10). Said notice has been issued to the effect that the petitioner has wrongly been promoted by considering his name in the seniority list of mechanic trade. While issuing said notice, the petitioner has been asked to submit his reply to the notice within a period of ten days. It is also an admitted fact that no reply to said notice has been furnished by the petitioner and in stead of filing reply, the petitioner has approached this Court.

The arguments which have been raised before this Court should have been mentioned in the reply but no reply has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to file reply of the Show Cause Notice but he submits that the respondent authorities have

already made up their mind to pass the order of reversion as is clear from the notice itself.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, A.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

By considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice, which was to be filed within a period of ten days, in case, the petitioner furnishes reply to the notice within a period of one week only from today, the respondent authorities are directed to consider the same.

In case, any adverse order is to be passed then the petitioner is granted ten days' time to challenge the said order.

However, the respondents are directed not to pass final order within the aforesaid period of ten days.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
