As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the insurance company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousands only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant -Gaurav Sharma son of Vijay Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.30,000/-(Rupees Thirty Thousands only) favouring appellant-Gaurav Sharma son of Vijay Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within two months. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
