By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits including the arrears of pensionary benefits, gratuity, leave encashment, dearness allowance, along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated September 27, 2017 (P-4) was made to respondent No.4 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (P-4) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, as well as in view of judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 25159 of 2016

(P-5), rules and regulations and instructions issued by Government of Punjab from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
