By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count her daily wages service, rendered by her before regularization, as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits with further prayer that the petitioner is entitled to the pensionary benefits as per Old General Provident Fund Scheme, which was applicable to the employees recruited in Punjab Government prior to 1.1.2004 in view of the judgment laid down by this Court in CWP No. 2371 of 2010 (P-3) with further prayer to treat the petitioner to be governed by GPF Scheme and receive pensionary benefits, as are available to the employees, recruited in Punjab Government service prior to 1.1.2004.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated January 16, 2017 (Annexure P-7) was moved to the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation (Annexure P-7) and to take a conscious decision as per rules, regulations, instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of judgment passed in CWP No. 2371 of 2010 (P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
