JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits including ex-gratia and family pension.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the petitioner namely Surjit Singh was taken away by the nature on January 21, 2015 during his service but till date benefits accrued to the petitioner on account of death of her husband has not so far been released, who are none else but widow, daughter and son of the deceased. He further submits that though a legal notice dated October 25, 2017 (Annexure P-3) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and dispose of the legal notice (Annexure P-3) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (Annexure P-3) and to take a conscious decision as per rules, regulations, instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) set out in the legal notice (P-3), to release the same immediately, if there is no impediment legal or otherwise.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
