JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant her family pension along-with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the petitioner died in harness on July 10, 2017 but till date benefits accrued to the petitioner on account of death of her husband has not so far been released. He further submits that petitioner made a representation dated November 10, 2017 (P-10), which also did not fetch any reply. He feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation (Annexure P-10) and to take a conscious decision as per rules, regulations, instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) set out in her representation (P-10), to release the same immediately, if there is no impediment legal or otherwise.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
