The challenge in the present writ petition is to the transfer order dated 27.11.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner has been sent back to Gurugram, in compliance of the order dated 09.11.2017 issued by the Director, State Transport Haryana, Chandigarh.

It is not disputed that the petitioner had stayed at Gurugram only for two months and, thereafter, had been transferred to Jind. It is a matter of fact that on account of the large scale transfers in the transport department, various directions had been issued by this Court in at least three bunch of cases. Directions had also been issued in **CWP No.17899 of 2017 'Rajender Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others'** and connected cases on 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) that let a proper transfer policy be framed and drivers and conductors should not be posted out before 2 years. Once the petitioner has been sent back to Gurugram, this Court is of the opinion that in view of the directions issued by this Court transfers have been made to streamline the process by the department.

Resultantly, this Court does not feel it fit to interfere in the transfer order and the present writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed in limine.
