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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that the daily wage service followed by regular service should be computed for the purpose of retiral benefits. The second claim is for the benefit of Assured Career Progression (in short 'ACP') from 30.5.1997 to 10.9.2007 on the post of ALM. The benefit of ACP has been granted during the pendency of the present writ petition.

It comes out from the petition that according to the petitioner, he worked on daily wage basis with Haryana Electricity Department, Sub Division Farukh Nagar, District Gurgaon with effect from 11.8.1980 till his services were regularized on 18.5.1993. He retired as AFM on 31.12.2012.

In the short reply, respondents have taken the stand that the petitioner worked in various offices and his service record is being collected and that now the case of the petitioner for counting his daily wage

service followed by regular service for the purpose of grant of revised benefits is under process.

Heard.

After hearing both the learned counsels for the parties, it is directed that since respondents have not disputed the daily wage service of the petitioner, therefore, the daily wage service of the petitioner is found to have been rendered by him followed by regular service shall be computed for the purpose of grant of retiral benefits. Accordingly, the pension of the petitioner shall be re-fixed and he shall be released the arrears within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order alongwith interest as per the instructions of the Government.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of.
