RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

The petitioner joined the Central Industrial Security Force on 5.7.2009. He is a hockey player, who has prayed for a direction to respondents No.3 & 4 to appoint the board of experts to conduct the fair trial for selection of the hockey team of CISF and also allow him to join practice camp at Chandigarh under respondent No.4.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the available record with his able assistance.

The petitioner has already been informed vide letter Annexure P-2 which read as under: -

“The performance of CISF Hockey team was evaluated by a Board of Officers and as per recommendation of the board, CT/CD Gurjit Singh was weeded out from Central Hockey team on 28.12.15. The petitioner was informed that if he still wants to be

included in the team, he may participate in the All India CISF Inter Sector competition where BOO would assess his performance and according to the recommendations his case will be decided by FHQ. However, CT/GD has been counselled time to time by the Area Commander.”

Otherwise also the tone and tenor of the representation made by the petitioner is not found to be in good taste and does not reflect the attitude of a sportsman.

Consequently, finding no merit in the present petition the same is hereby dismissed.
