JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release pensionary benefits in terms of regular monthly pension, GPF, gratuity, leave encashment etc. along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date it became due till its realization.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 11.10.2017 (Annexure P-2), within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 11.10.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take a conscious decision, within a period of

two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if there is no legal impediment, to make the payment within a period of next one month.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
