This petition is filed for prohibiting respondent No.1 from issuing warrant of possession in respect of the land in question.

Pursuant to the order dated 13.2.2017, despite the fact that the said order has been set aside vide order dated 27.7.2017, and in pursuance to the order dated 28.11.2017, the parties have been directed to appear before the Tehsildar-cum-Collector, Grade-I (respondent No.1), wherein the matter was listed for 21.12.2017, the petitioners are apprehending that before the matter is heard on 21.12.2017 by respondent No.1, they may not be divested of their possession.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances, am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in the present petition as it is only a presumption of the petitioners on the basis of which no order, as prayed for,

can be passed. In any case, if any adverse order is passed against the petitioners, they would be entitled to challenge the same in accordance with law.
