The petitioner-Gram Panchayat is aggrieved by the order dated 19.09.2017 passed by the Collector, Nuh whereby an interim stay order passed by the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade Nuh directing the parties to maintain *status-quo* re: *shamlat deh*, has been stayed. The resultant effect of the impugned order passed by the Collector, Nuh is that the private respondents, most of whom are builders-cum-developers would be able to enter into sale and purchase of the land in dispute.

We, however, find from the record that the petitioner-Gram Panchayat has also filed a revision petition before the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon against the order dated 19.09.2017 of the Collector, Nuh. The stay application has also been moved on which no order has been passed by the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon. In this view of the matter, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the learned Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon to take up the revision petition filed by the petitioner-Gram Panchayat and decide the same in accordance with law as early as possible and preferably within a period of

such time, the order dated 19.09.2017 of the Collector, Nuh, shall remain stayed and order dated 06.09.2017 passed by the ACIG, Nuh shall be complied with by the parties.
