In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged order dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P10). Before passing order dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P10) petitioner had approached this court for deciding the interim application by way of writ petition No. 23057 of 2017 and it was decided on 12.12.2017 while deciding CWP No. 23057 of 2017 request has been made to the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour court to decide the reference within a period of 6 months.
