Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similarly situated person namely Kanta Rani has approached this Court by way of filing CWP No.1933 of 2014, which was decided on 28.10.2014 and said petitioner has been regularised in that case, but the claim of the petitioners has not been considered in spite of making representation dated 22.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to the respondents to consider the pending representation dated 22.09.2017 (Annexure P-3).

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and by considering the submission that similarly situated person namely Kanta Rani has been regularised in view of order dated 28.10.2014 passed in CWP No.1933 of 2014, the present writ petition is disposed of

with a direction to respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners. In case the claim of the petitioners is at par with Kanta Rani, the necessary relief be granted to them within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the respondents come to the conclusion that claim of the petitioners is different, then a detailed speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners.
