The D.D.P.O.-cum-Collector, Jalandhar passed an order dated 29.03.2016 (issued on 12.04.2016), whereby an *ex-parte* direction was issued to take possession of the property in dispute which is claimed to be in possession of the petitioner. As soon as the petitioner came to know about that order, he moved an application dated 06.09.2016 to recall the said *ex-parte* order. The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that the aforesaid application has not been decided so far.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits of his claim, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Collector-cum-DDPO, Jalandhar to decide the above-stated application in accordance with law and by passing a reasoned order, within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
