Notice of motion.

On our asking, Mr.Rajesh Bhardwaj, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let five copies of the writ petition be handed-over to him during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the nature of order which we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any counter-reply from the respondents at this stage as no order prejudicial to their interest is being passed.

The petitioner is contesting the election of Councilor of Municipal Corporation, Patiala from Ward No.20. He apprehends that the election process is not likely to be conducted in a fair, impartial and free manner. Hence, a direction is sought for videographing the election process.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties though we do not find any material on record to substantiate the petitioner's allegations,

nevertheless, in the interest of justice and to ensure that the election is conducted in a fair and impartial manner, the authorities are directed to videograph the polling and counting of votes of Ward No.20, Patiala and assess the threat perception, if any, to the petitioner and take necessary remedial action in accordance with law.

Since the election is scheduled to be held tomorrow (17.12.2017), let a copy of this order be given *dasti* to learned State counsel during the course of day under the signatures of the Bench Secretary. The State counsel shall fax or e-mail the copy of this order to the Deputy Commissioner, Patiala immediately for information and necessary compliance.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
