The petitioners have approached this Court seeking following relief:-

"Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a suitable writ, direction, order in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent's to take all necessary steps and actions required to form a separate Gram Panchayat of the Village Ram Garh Channo as per the provisions of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and consider the representations of the petitioners dated 08.06.2013, 28.06.2016, 23.08.2013 (Annexure P-1) and further set

aside any order whereby the claim of the petitioners as claimed vide above said representations has been rejected if at all by the respondents.

OR

Any other Writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and appropriate may kindly be granted in the facts and circumstances of the case."

As per stand of the respondent(s) taken in paragraph 2 of the written statement, there is a proposal for the inclusion of the area of the Village Ramgarh Chhano in the municipal limits of Committee, Indri, which reads as under:-

"2. That the Director, Urban Local Bodies Haryana, Chandigarh vide letter No.3AE/2015/65836 dated 27.11.2015 intimated the answering respondent that the Govt. has directed to send a proposal for the inclusion of the area of village Ramgrah Chhano in the municipal limits of Committee, Indri. It was further written in the letter that the case of this inclusion may be sent to the Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, Chandigarh as per the guidelines of the Govt. issued vide letter No.53/278-08-3CI dated 03.03.2009. The copy of letter dated 27.11.2015 is annexed as Annexure R-1 for the kind perusal of the Hon'ble High Court."

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition and it is expected that the State Government shall take appropriate measures regarding proposal as expeditiously as possible.

Since the main writ petition is dismissed, the application

bearing CM No.13260 of 2015 seeking impleadment of the applicant, namely, Ram Kishan as respondent No.4, has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of, accordingly.
