Learned counsel files the fresh power of attorney on behalf of
respondent No.7, superseding the earlier counsel, which is taken on record.

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to be
issued to the respondents to release pending dues of provident fund, in
terms of Punjab University Calendar Vol-I, Chapter VIII(E).

Learned counsel for the respondents urge that this petition

ought to be transferred before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab, constituted under Section 7-A of the Punjab Affiliated Colleges (Security of Service of Employees) Act, 1974, since the petitioner herein was working in a privately affiliated college.

In view of the above, since this court does not have the jurisdiction to entertain the matter, the instant writ petition is ordered to be transferred and placed before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab under the said Act. The Registry is directed to do the needful within a period of 15 days from today. The parties through their respective counsel are directed to appear before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab on 24.05.2017.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
