Pleadings on record indicate that the petitioner has been serving on the post of Peon (daily wage basis) continuously since the year 2006 under the Punjab Nurses Registration Council.

The precise grievance put forth is that in spite of the claim of the petitioner for regularization having been deliberated upon on more than two occasions by the respondent-Council, no final decision on his claim has been taken. In support of the contention that the Punjab Nurses Registration Council was seized of the issue for grant of benefit of regularization to the petitioner, counsel would advert to the documents placed on record at Annexure P-8 i.e. the proceedings of the Council meeting held on 11.01.2015.

Counsel submits that she would be satisfied if at this

stage directions were to be issued to the respondent-Council to take a final decision on the representation claiming regularization and which has already been submitted.

Submission advanced by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

As such without going into the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Registrar, Punjab Nurses Registration Council to examine the claim of the petitioner and to take a final decision on the representation dated 11.08.2017 (Annexure P-9) expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
