In view of the preliminary objection that has been taken, the petitioners seek liberty to withdraw the instant writ petition in order to approach the competent authority with a prayer that the interim order passed in the instant petition be maintained till such time as they approach the competent authority.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioners to file his revision under Section 42 of the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961. In case the revision is filed within a period of two weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order, the impugned order shall remain stayed till that date.

Since the petitioner herein had approached this Court, the question of limitation will not be agitated in order to defeat their claim on

technical ground.

Writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
