Petitioner seeks transfer of vending licence at Railway Station Kotkapura claiming that it was earlier in the name of his father who had died on 04.12.2014.

Without expression of any opinion on merits at this stage, I am of the opinion that it is prerogative of the original authorities to consider such claim as per the policy issued by the General Manager, Ministry of Railways.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Northern Railway, Ferozpur to consider the claim of the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with the policies applicable, in such circumstances, within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, an application for transfer of vending licence, has not been received in the office of Northern Railway Division, Ferozpur, the contents of the petition may be considered as the representation.

It will be the responsibility of the petitioner to communicate the copy of the order along with copy of the writ petition in the office of Northern Railway Division, Ferozepur for adjudication of the claim of the petitioner.
