The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, by way of Public Interest Litigation (PIL), seeking direction to the respondents not to shift the existing Old Judicial Complex, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur to rural area of Village Bajwara, Hoshiarpur, as the same does not watch paramount interest of public and is stated to be unconstitutional.

2. After arguing for sometime, when the Bench was not agreeing with the petitioners and observed that the present petition is totally frivolous and abuse of the process of Court of Law, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition.
