As per pleadings on record, petitioner was selected and appointed as Mali under the Punjab State Education Department in the year 2001. Petitioner is stated to have worked continuously ever since and without having earned any promotions.

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of possessing the requisite number of years of regular service, the benefit under the ACP Scheme upon completion of 9 and 14 years of service has not been released to the petitioner.

Without going into the merits of the case and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with directions to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director, Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab to examine the claim of the petitioner and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 16.10.2017 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously and in any case within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
