As per pleadings on record petitioner was appointed as Oil Cleaner under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and subsequently promoted as Sub Station Attendant (SSA) on 25.05.2013.

Grievance raised in the petition is that various service benefits accruing in the years 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 have not been released to the petitioner.

An innocuous prayer for issuance of writ of mandamus has been raised to direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and to decide his representation/legal notice and to release benefits under different instructions/notifications/amendments issued from time to time by the respondent Corporation.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, I find

that the relief sought is utterly vague.

The precise service benefit which has not been released to the petitioner is not even indicated. Even the relevant instructions/notifications that may have been issued by the Punjab State Power Corporation and under which the petitioner alleges to have been entitled to certain service benefits have not been placed on record. Such instructions/notifications have not even been adverted to in the body of the petition.

Under such circumstances no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a petition afresh but with better particulars.
