JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the military service rendering during the Second National Emergency from 03.12.1971 to 25.03.1977 towards the pensionary benefits as per order dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP No.17661-2013, titled as ***“Rajinder Singh v. State of Punjab and others”*** by this Court and after counting the emergency period towards the pensionary benefits, revised pensionary benefits and pay the consequential benefits to him along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to

respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 25.02.2015 (Annexure P-2) as per order dated 13.11.2014, passed in CWP No. 17661 of 2013, titled as “**Rajinder Singh v. State of Punjab and others**”, within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is partly allowed with a direction to respondent(s) to consider the case of the petitioner as unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 25.02.2015 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same in the light of law laid down in CWP No.17661 of 2013, “**Rajinder Singh v. State of Punjab and others**”, decided on 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-1) , within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feel aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
