Learned counsel for the respondents has raised a preliminary objection about the maintainability of the petition on the ground that in Clause 17 of the allotment letter it is provided that in case of any dispute arising between the Housefed and the society or allottee, it shall be referred to the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab, whose decision shall be final and binding upon the parties.

Faced with this objection, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to avail his remedy in terms of Clause 17 of the allotment letter.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
