Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that during the pendency of the present writ petition, after depositing the amount towards CPF the previous service of the petitioner has been counted and the arrears thereof has been released to him. Now, his only claim is with regard to the interest on the delayed payment of the arrears.

It comes out from the reply of the respondents that soon after the amount towards CPF was deposited by the petitioner, his previous service was counted and the arrears were released to him forthwith.

I am of the view that since, there is no delay on the part of the respondent-department in releasing the arrears, therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to the interest on the arrears.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.
