The petitioner intends adopting proceedings whether in the Civil Court or before the authorities concerned to establish that it is a bonafide purchaser for value without notice and that the sale in its favour and/or in favour of its predecessor in title was not with an intention of defrauding the revenue.

2. The petition is disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.

3. In the event of it being held for any reason that the petitioner is not entitled to any alternate remedy and such proceedings are not decided on merits, the petitioner shall be entitled to file a fresh petition.
