Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the time when the driving test was conducted, the petitioner was told that he has cleared the test but after two hours he was told the contrary.

He submits that in respect of his grievance he made a representation dated 14.12.2017 (Annexure P-3) to the Secretary of the respondent Commission and therefore, this petition may be disposed of with a direction to the aforesaid respondent to take a decision on the aforesaid representation after seeing the videographic recording of the driving test, duly showing the same to the petitioner also.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with the aforesaid direction, with the the Secretary of the respondent Commission to pass a speaking order within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In the meanwhile, one post shall not be filled up in the category of the petitioner.

A copy of the videographic recording be also given to the petitioner.

It is also clarified that in case a speaking order has already been passed giving such detailed reasons, then only a short order need be passed, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed(if any).
