Vide impugned order Annexure P-8 dated 18.01.2016, petitioner No.2 has been directed to release permanent electric connection to respondent No.1 by the Permanent Lok Adalat. Vide impugned order, application of respondent No.1 has been allowed and a direction has been issued to released DS-tariff electric connection (permanent electric connection) to respondent No.1 by the petitioners subject to payment of charges according to the tariff, under the rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that temporary connection has already been granted to respondent No.1 but on account of developer having not fulfilled certain formalities and on account of order passed by the Pollution Control Board, regular electric connection cannot be granted.

Counsel for the petitioners has brought to the notice of this Court that CWP-7883-2016 and other connected cases titled Chief Engineer, Border Range, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd and another Vs. Pargat Singh and another, on the assurance given by the developer and

he having already submitted requisite documents, has been dismissed but a direction has been issued to fulfill the other statutory obligations by the developer.

In view of said judgment, order dated 18.01.2016 cannot be set aside. However, it is observed that as per the directions in CWP No. 7883 of 2016, statutory obligations will be fulfilled by the developer and in case the petitioner has to perform any formalities, he would also fulfill the same.

This petition is dismissed with above observations.
