TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

As per pleadings on record, father of the petitioner, namely, Kulwant Singh and who was working as Sewadar-cum-Attendant (Class-IV) post on a regular basis in the Department of Animal Husbandry, State of Punjab died in harness on 16.09.2011. Petitioner without any delay submitted an application dated 05.11.2011 (Annexure P-2) seeking an appointment on compassionate basis.

The precise grievance raised in the petition is that till date no final decision has been taken and conveyed to the petitioner as regards his claim for compassionate appointment.

Counsel during the course of hearing has even adverted to the documents placed on record at Annexures P-4, P-5, P-6 and P-9 to contend that the claim of the petitioner has been

under active consideration and rather has even been recommended.

In view of the above and without making any observations on merits, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to respondent No.1-Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry, Punjab/competent authority to treat the present petition itself as a representation and to take a final decision on the claim of the petitioner seeking compassionate appointment in accordance with law and under the relevant policy/instructions issued by the State Government on the subject of compassionate appointment.

Let such final decision be taken within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition disposed of.
