The petitioners had earlier approached this Court by way of
CWP No.27953 of 2017 which was dismissed as withdrawn on 8.12.2017
with the following order: -

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners prays
for withdrawal of the present petition with
liberty to file an appeal under the provisions
of the relevant statute.*

*Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid
liberty.”*

Thereafter, the petitioners had allegedly filed appeal before the
appellate authority on 11.12.2017 along with an application for stay.

It is submitted that the District Registrar, Ambala has not given
any date of hearing in the appeal whereas the election which is sought to be
stalled by the petitioners is on 23.12.2017.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners in this regard and after perusal of the record, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the appellate authority i.e. District Registrar, Ambala to take up the appeal of the petitioners on 22.12.2017 positively and also pass an appropriate order in the application for stay, in case the appeal cannot be decided on the same day.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
