This order shall dispose of three petitions bearing CWP Nos. 29271, 29276 and 29279 of 2017 as the issue involved in these petitions is common. However, for the sake of convenience, the facts are being extracted from the CWP No. 29271 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed the revision i.e. R.O.R. No. 471 of 2017 before the Financial Commissioner, Haryana against the order passed by the Assistant

Collector Ist Grade, Rohtak in which the petitioner has been proceeded against *ex parte*. It is submitted that the said revision was filed on 17.08.2017 and was adjourned for 23.10.2017, 11.12.2017 and 18.12.2017 as on none of the dates, the Financial Commissioner was thereto hold the Court. It is further submitted that no date has been given even after 18.12.2017.

The only prayer made in these petitions is, thus to issue an appropriate direction to the Financial Commissioner, seized of the revision petitions filed by the petitioner, to take up the aforesaid matters on the next date of hearing and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the Financial Commissioner, who is seized of the revision petitions filed by the petitioner, to take up the said revisions on 22.12.2017 positively and pass the appropriate orders.
