By this common order, all the four civil writ petitions i.e. CWP

Nos. 8986, 9082, 9099 of 2015 and 4773 of 2016 are being decided together as common questions of law and facts are involved in these writ petitions. However, for brevity, facts have been taken from CWP No.8986 of 2015.

The grievance of the petitioners is relating to entitlement of regularization from 01.10.2003, date on which juniors and similarly situated employees' services have been regularized. In this regard, the petitioners are stated to have submitted their representation dated 20.08.2014 (Annexure P/4). The respondents have not passed any order. On the other hand, they have just merely denied the entitlement of the petitioners for regularization from 01.10.2003. Therefore, the competent authority is directed to pass a speaking order after due consideration of the petitioners' representation dated 20.08.2014 and also whether the petitioners' juniors/similarly situated employees' services have been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003 or not and after due examination of service particulars. The competent authority is directed to take a decision within a period of three months from today and communicate the same to the petitioners. In the meanwhile, if the petitioners intend to submit any additional representation, they are permitted to file it within a period of two weeks from today.

All the aforesaid four writ petitions stand disposed of.
