It is contended that the petitioner has applied for appointment on compassionate ground as well as taking action against his sister-respondent No. 4 herein for obtaining a job fraudulently.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that representation had been preferred as far back as in August, 2016, however, no action has been taken thereon. Counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer for early disposal of the representation that has been preferred.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of the receipt of a certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
