By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant her IIIrd ACP grade pay of ₹5400/- w.e.f. 01.09.2013, accordingly release her revised pension and other pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated October 15, 2017 (P-1) was served upon the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (P-1) within some stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-1) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
